- (e) Under the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), provision exists for the construction of Community Sanitary Complexes (CSC). The unit assistance available for construction of CSCs is Rs.2 lakh with a sharing ratio amongst Central Government, State Government and the Community of 60:30:10. Ordinarily such Complexes will be constructed only when there is lack of space in the village for construction of household toilets. The CSCs are to be constructed only on demand of the Gram Panchayats and after ensuring that adequate Operation and Maintenance arrangements are in place.
