Under rural sanitation programme, the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) {SBM(G)}, projects are sanctioned district-wise. Currently 627 district sanitation projects are under implementation. State/UT wise sanitation projects are at Annexure II. Since SBM(G) is a demand driven scheme, no State/UT-wise allocations are made. However, State/UT-wise central share released and Individual household latrines constructed under the Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC)/ Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan (NBA)/ {SBM(G)} during last 3 years and current year is at Annexure-III.
