(c) the status of progress made along with the agency appointed for the purpose, project-wise; and

(d) the funds allocated, released and utilised for the purpose during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise?

(a) The State / Union Territory-wise details of total length of National Highways (NHs) and length of NHs having four or more lane are at Annexure-I.

(b) and (c) Four-laning of NHs has mainly taken up under various phases of National Highways Development Project (NHDP) and Special Accelerated Road Development Programme for the North- Eastern Region (SARDP-NE). Under these programmes, it is targeted to upgrade 32,362 km of NHs including NH-6 & NH-17 to four-lane standard. So far, four-laning has been has been completed in 19,603 km upto March, 2014 and works are at various stages of progress for rest of the stretches.

(d) Allocation of funds for development of NHs are made State / Union Territory-wise and not NH/project-wise. The year-wise and State / Union territory-wise details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred for development of NHs during each of the last three year and the current year are at Annexure-II. In addition private sector also contributes towards four- laning of NHs.
