- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which such districts are likely to be included under the SRE scheme?

STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NUMBER 334 FOR 16.12.2014

- (a): The State-wise list of districts covered under the Security Related Expenditure (SRE) Scheme for Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected States is annexed.
- (b): On the basis of violence profile, presently 106 districts of the 10 LWE affected States are covered under the SRE Scheme.
- (c) to (d): Proposals are received from the State Governments from time to time for inclusion of more districts under the SRE Scheme. Recently, the State Government of Odisha has requested for inclusion of additional two districts namely, Boudh and Sonepur under the SRE Scheme. Inclusion/exclusion of districts under SRE Scheme are based on violence profile. This is a continuous process and it is not possible to indicate a time frame.
