- (b) whether the State Government of Karnataka has changed the names of 12 cities recently without the approval of the Union Government:

- (d) whether the Government has any proposal to change the names of various cities and to give them Indian names;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes to set up a Commission to look into the issue of renaming of cities and giving them historical names and if so, the details thereof?

Thereafter, if found appropriate, the Ministry conveys its 'No Objection' to the State Government concerned for issuing required Gazette Notification.
