- (a): In order to facilitate growth of the textile industry in the country, Government has implemented various policy initiatives and schemes, viz. Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (TUFS), Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP), Scheme for Develop- ment of Technical Textiles, Integrated Skill Develop- ment Scheme (ISDS), Schemes for the development of the Powerloom Sector, National Handloom Develop- ment Programme, Handloom Weavers Comprehen- sive Welfare Scheme, etc.
- (b): These schemes are applicable to all the States/ UTs including West Bengal, for the small, medium & large textile units/mills.
- (c): Details of implementation status/ funds released under various schemes of Ministry of Textiles in West Bengal is at Annexure.
