(a) & (b): Under Plan Scheme, Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D) has sponsored 6 Research studies each in the year 2011 and 2012. Under Non-Plan Scheme 10, 8 and 5 research studies have been sponsored in the year 2011, 2012 and 2013 respectively, based on quality research proposals available.

(c) & (d): Yes Madam. This Ministry has approved a plan scheme namely "Training Intervention" at a cost of Rs. 36.96 Crore to be implemented during 12th Plan period. This is a continuing scheme from 11th Plan period and included in the current plan period (12th Plan period). The scheme was proposed with the objective to enhance the capability of police personnel in discharging their duties more effectively.
