- (a) the total number of cases of theft of vehicles registered in the country during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to create a portal at centre level for better coordination among the State Governments in this regard; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): A total of 1,51,200 cases, 1,54,351 cases and 1,65,690 cases of auto theft were registered during 2011, 2012 and 2013 respectively. State/UT wise incidence under Auto theft during 2011-2013 is enclosed at Annexure. The National Crime Records Bureau has also developed and hosted a website 'Vahan Samanvay', for coordination of stolen and received motor vehicle as well as inquiries thereto.
