- (a) whether the Government proposes to connect Ranchi, the capital of Jharkhand, to each district of the State with four lane national highways;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reason therefore?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI KRISHANPAL GURJAR)

(a) and (c): Presently only two districts namely Hazaribagh & Ramgarh are connected to Ranchi, the capital of Jharkhand with four lane National Highways through NH-33. Currently no such proposal to connect Ranchi, the capital of Jharkhand to each district of the Sate with four lane NHs as the development of NHs is being done based on traffic requirements and inter se-priority of funds along the existing length of National Highways.
