- (a) whether the Government has announced Road Construction Projects worth Rs. 3136 crores for Haryana on 25th June, 2014 in Chandigarh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which work on the said project is likely to be started?

**Answer**

(a) & (c) Four road projects namely; 4-lanning of Panchkula-Yamunanagar section of National Highway-73 (old), 4-lanning of Ambala-Kaithal section of National Highway-65 (old), 4-lanning Pinjaur- Baddi section of National Highway-21A (old) and taking up of Ambala-Saha-Shahabad road as new National Highway & its development to 4-lane for total cost of Rs. 3136 crore are under consideration by this Ministry for its implementation and these projects are at planning, design & tender stages. Since these projects are at various stages, the likely date of start of these projects may not be indicated at present.
