PATHETIC CONDITION OF HIGHWAYS

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the time by which the National Highway and State Highway roads connecting Banda-Baberu, Kamasin-Karvi, Rajapur-Banda-Viseda, which are in a very dilapidated condition are likely to be repaired;
- (b) the amount of funds released so far by the Government for the upkeep of the said highways;
- (c) whether all the funds released have been utilised for the said purpose; and
- (d) if not, the action likely to be taken by the Government against the people responsible for the same?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI KRISHANPAL GURJAR)

(a) to (d) This Ministry is primarily responsible for the development and maintenance of National Highways in the country. Development and maintenance of roads, other than National Highways, rests with respective State Governments. Banda-Baberu, Kamasin-Karvi, Rajapur-Banda- Viseda road is not a National Highway. As such, this road comes under the purview of the State Government.
