- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

- (a)& (b) In accordance with the scheme titled "Maintenance and Development of Memorials", a sum of Rs.10.00 lakh was sanctioned to the Lal Bahadur National Memorial Trust as one time grant during the 12th Plan period. Accordingly, Rs.6.75 lakh was released during the financial year 2013-14 and Rs.3.25 lakh during 2014-15.
- (c) & (d) No, Madam. This Ministry is not in receipt of any such decision so far. During the year 2014, the Ministry inaugurated three new commemorations, viz. birth centenary of Begum Akhtar, centenary of Komagata Maru incident and 125th birth anniversary of Jawaharlal Nehru.
