- (a) whether the Government has launched a Pilot Project under Clean India Campaign;
- (b) if so, the objectives and salient features thereof;
- (c) the names of the monuments identified under the said campaign; and
- (d) the fund allocated by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE, CULTURE AND TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) AND MINISTER OF STATE, CIVIL AVIATION (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) Hon'ble Minister of Culture, Government of India, launched Swacch Bharat Abhiyan on 25th September, 2014 from the premises of Red Fort, New Delhi under Clean India Campaign.
- (b) Launch focused on the initiative to clean all monuments premises and ensure:
 - (i) no garbage can be seen in the premises;
 - (ii) to provide adequate amenities for visitors to ensure no litter is thrown inside monuments; and
 - (iii) to sensitize visitors as well as staff in maintaining monuments clean.
- (c) The Campaign is followed for all protected monuments in the country so that they are maintained in a good state of preservation and cleanliness.
- (d) No fund has been earmarked for Clean India Campaign.
