Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has envisaged any policy/ programme for protection/ preservation/development/ revival and promotion of Indian tangible and intangible culture of various States of the country including Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof, State-wise and the action taken by the Government in this regard;

(b) the achievement made in this regard along with the funds allocated and utilized by the Government for the purpose during each of the last three years in the country, State-wise;

(c) whether the Government is ready to constitute Special Commission/ Committee for this purpose and if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government has set up a National Culture fund to preserve and develop Indian culture in collabo- ration with some private companies/institutions; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and the number of companies/ institutions who contributed to this fund?

(a) & (b): Ministry of Culture implements a number of schemes and programmes aimed at protection/ preservation/development/ revival and promotion of the tangible and intangible culture of the country including Maharashtra. The schemes are appli- cable to all States and therefore no State-wise funds are allocated.

(c): No such proposal is under consideration.

(d) & (e): The Ministry of Culture had established the National Culture Fund in 1996 as a Trust under the Charitable Endowments Act 1890. NCF's primary mandate is to establish and nurture Public Private Partnerships in the field of heritage and mobi-lize resources for the restoration, conservation, protection and development of India's rich, natural, tangible and intan-gible heritage. Around 35 Companies/ institutions have contri- buted to this fund.
