Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps to complete the work of six-laning of NH-1 from Delhi upto Amritsar;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI KRISHANPAL GURJAR)

(a) to (c) : Delhi Panipat section of NH-1 (old) is already six/eight lane. Six laning work from km. 96.00 to km. 387.100 of Panipat-Jalandhar section is at standstill because of litigation. Honble Supreme Court vide orders dated 17.4.2014 and 24.4.2014 has directed the Concessionaire to complete the work by 31.3.2015. Six laning from km. 387.100 to km. 407.100 of Jalandhar-Amritsar section has commenced in January 2014. Balance length of Jalandhar- Amritsar section from km. 407.100 to 456.100 is already four lane and presently does not qualify for six laning.
