## MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI ARUN JAITLEY)

(a) to (d): On the advice of Government of India, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) had constituted a Committee for designing future currency notes in October, 2010. The Committee, inter alia, deliberated on the issue of changing the existing image of Mahatma Gandhi and inclusion of certain other personalities in the new design of banknotes. After due consideration, the Committee decided that no other personality could better represent the ethos of India than Mahatma Gandhi.
