- (a) the details of various Centrally sponsored schemes run by the Government for development of inland and marine fisheries sector;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated/sanctioned and released by the Government to various States under these Schemes during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to revise unit cost as well as corresponding subsidy thereon taking the schedule rate and prevailing market rate into consideration, if so, the details thereof; (d) whether the Government has given the directions to the insurance companies to insure the fish pond in Odisha; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

- (a)& (b) The Department is implementing the following Centrally Sponsored scheme for development of Inland & Marine fisheries sector in the country.
- (i) Centrally Sponsored Scheme on 'Development of Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture'.
- (ii) Centrally Sponsored Scheme on `Development of Marine Fisheries, Infrastructure and Post Harvest Operations`.

The amount sanctioned & released under these scheme during each of the last three year and the current year, state wise is annexed.

- (c) The Government has proposed the revision of unit cost during the remaining years of 12 Plan which is subject to necessary approval.
- (d) The Department has not given the directions to the insurance companies to insure fish ponds in Odisha.
