(a) to (d) Prasar Bharati (DG:DD) has informed that a proposal has been received from Doordarshan Kendra (DDK), Hyderabad to create an interim set up of new Regional Kendra of Doordarshan at Vijayawada for Andhra Pradesh to maintain the cultural and economic identities of the State.

Currently, Doordarshan Vijayawada is a PGF (Programme Generating Facility) and there is a proposal to start 2-hours' terrestrial transmission from 05:00PM to 07:00PM (including 15 Minutes Telugu news Bulletin) as an interim arrangement and rest of 22-hours of transmission will be relayed from DDK, Hyderabad. Necessary instruction has been issued to the concerned by Directorate of Doordarshan in this regard.
