Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to re-introduce `Kisan Vikas Patra` (KVPs) from all post offices across the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the rate of interes at which these are likely to be issued?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI RAVI SHANKAR PRASAD)

- (a) Yes Madam. Kisan Vikas Patra (KVP) Scheme has been re-introduced from all Departmental Post Offices across the country.
- (b) The details of re-introduced KVP scheme at present are as under:-
- (i) The scheme gives assured two times return after 100 months.
- (ii) Rate of interest is 8.7%.
- (iii) There is no ceiling of investment in Kisan Vikas Patra.
- (iv) Kisan Vikas Patra may be issued to an adult for himself or on behalf of a minor or to a minor.
- (v) Kisan Vikas Patra may be issued jointly to two adults payable to both holders jointly or to the survivor.
- (vi) Investors are permitted to make encashment any time after expiry of two years and six months from the date of purchasing of Kisan Vikas Patra.
- (vii) Kisan Vikas Patra are available in denomination of Rs. 1,000/-, Rs. 5,000/-, Rs.10,000/- and Rs. 50,000/-.
- (viii) Kisan Vikas Patra may be transferred from one Post Office to other Post Office.
- (ix) Kisan Vikas Patra may be transferred from one person to other person.
- (x) Kisan Vikas Patra may be encashed at the Post Office of its issue or at any other Post Office after due verification.
