- (a) whether major chemical accidents have occurred in chemical factories;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the casualties caused by the accidents during the last three years;
- (c) the type of chemical harmful for public;
- (d) whether the legislation/rules regarding disaster and accidents in chemical factories including safe transporation of chemicals and hazardous material are being followed strictly in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the remedial measures taken/being taken to control sub accidents in future?

(a) and (b): Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climat Change is the nodal Ministry to look after the issues of chemical accidents in chemical factories under the provi- sions of `The Chemical Accidents (Emergency Planning, Preparendess, and Response) Rules. 1996. As per the available information, the details of accidents and deaths occurred in the chemical accidents are as under:-

(c): The list of hazardous chemicals which are harmful for public are given in Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989, framed under Environmet Protection Act, 1986.
