Consultations with State Governments are being held by Ministry of Urban Development. The Guidelines for selection of cities shall be finalized after approval of the scheme.
- (b): A combined allocation of ? 2.00 crore for New Mission, including development of Smart Cities, along with an allocation of ? 6273.77 crore for Mission for development of 100 Smart Cities and JnNURM has been made by the Government in the current financial year.
