(a) to (d): Ministry of Information & Broadcasting is in the process of the implementation of a new Plan Scheme 'National Film Heritage Mission' to restore, digitize and archive of films and filmic material. Planning Commission has accorded 'in principle' approval to the scheme. Finance Ministry's approval has also been obtained too and Expenditure Finance Committee(EFC) has recommended the implementation of the scheme for consideration of Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs(CCEA). Administrative approval would be issued once the CCEA approves the proposal.
