- (c) the amount incurred so far in Udaypur Tribal Division of Rajasthan?

- (a) Under National Rural Development Water Programme (NRDWP), 10 percent of the funds are allocated under Scheduled Tribe component for ST population in the country.
- (b) State-wise fund allocated and released under this component during last three years and current year are at Annexure-I.
- (c) As per the data entered by the State on the Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the Ministry an amount of Rs. 245.23 lakhs has been incurred in Udaypur Tribal Division comprising districts of Banswada , Chittaurgargarh , Dungarpur , Pratapgarh , Rajsamand and Udaipur districts under Scheduled Tribe (Programme Fund) of NRDWP during the current financial year 2014.
