(a) to (c) No, Madam. As per the present tariff framework in the country, the tariff for internet services is under forbearance. The telecom service providers (TSPs) have the flexibility to offer different tariff plans and schemes for Internet with multiple combination of fixed charges. Periods of validity, download/upload speeds and usage charges. Different tariff combinations are being offered by the TSPs depending on the market conditions and other commercial conditions. Thus, the Internet tariffs differ from tariff plan to tariff plan and for different service areas. There have been both upward and downword revisions in tariff offerings during the last one year,
