(a) to (d): Yes, Madam, Congestion has been noticed in many parts of Delhi. Recently, some of the daily newspapers have published many articles on the congestion in Delhi. Taking note of these articles en daily newspapers, Hon'hle Urban Development Minister has constituted a High Powered Inter-ministerial Committee to prepare a Detailed Action Plan on 'How to Decongest Delhi'. As far as East Kidwai problem is concerned, it is due to phase-III construction by Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) and redevelopment of East Kidwai Nagar by National Building Construction Corporation Limited (NBCC).
