**Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether incidents of theft/interception of satellite signals has come to the notice of the Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any investigation in this regard;
- (d) if so, the outcome thereof and the action taken against the guilty persons;
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?
