SHORTAGE OF WATER IN DDA FLATS

**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the complaints are being received from residents of DDA flats located in different parts of city including Dwarka regarding scarcity and short supply of water and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the scarcity of water is due to technical problems, faulty network of distribution lines resulting in low pressure in certain areas including in Dwarka; and
- (c) if so, the details of the steps taken to rectify the defects in pipelines and restore proper water supply in DDA flats?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M.VENKAIAH NAIDU)

(a) : Yes, Madam. Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has informed that complaints are being received from the residents of some DDA flats including those in Dwarka for scarcity & short supply of water.

(b) & (c)s Delhi Development Authority (DDA) receives water from Delhi JaS Board (DJB) and distributes the same to DDA flats. The scarcity of water is mainly due to shortage of water.
