(a) & (b) The Action Plan drawn under the Namami Gange, the Integrated Ganga Conservation Mission contemplates encouragement to the use of different kinds of improved and environment-friendly methods of cremation on the banks of Ganga and its tributaries. These methods are also likely to provide scientific disposal of ashes and other matter, (c) & (d) An Expert Committee has been constituted to examine the feasibility and suitability of new technology applications in different areas of pollution abatement, including eco-friendly methods of cremation. The Committee comprises of Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board, Convener of 1IT Consortium and Director, NEERI, Nagpur.
