(a) whether a number of Multi-National Companies (MNCs) functioning in the country have . closed down their operations;

(b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years and the current year and the reasons therefore, MNC and State-wise;

(c) the reaction of the Government thereto;

(d) whether certain MNCs functioning in Tamil Nadu are on the verge of closure and if so, the details thereof and the reason therefore;

(e) whether the Government has any plan for rehabilitation of the employees of the MNCs that had been closed down and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): The role of Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) is confined to administer 32 Central Public Sector Enterprises under its administrative control. Therefore, DHI does not maintain any data of Multi-National Companies (MNCs) functioning in the country. Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion has also not reported any such development.
