(a) to (c) The Department of Land Resources provides funds to the States/UTs under National Land Records Modernization Programme for digitization of land records and other related activities and reviews implementation of the programme during review meetings with the States and UTs. The States and UTs are at the various stages of implementation of digitization of land records. The States/UTs which have completed or have made considerable progress in computerization of land records i.e. Record of Rights include Andhra Pradesh, Assam (Partial), Chhattisgarh, Gujarat. Goa, Haryana. Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra. Manipur (Partial), Odisha, Punjab. Rajasthan, Sikkim, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh. Uttarakhand, West Bengal (Partial), Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman 8c Diu, and Puducherry. State/UT-wise details of funds released during the last three years and the current year for different components of National Land Records Modernization Programme and the utilization are given at the Annexre.
