- (b) whether the Government proposes to discontinue the said scheme and replace it with a new scheme across the country; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the new scheme is likely to be implemented?

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI MANEKA SANJAY GANDHI)

- (a) Main features of the scheme:
- # Day care facilities are provided to the children (age group of 0-6 years) of working women and other deserving women.
- # The Scheme provides supplementary nutrition, health care inputs like immunization, polio drops, basic health monitoring, early stimulation for below 3 years, pre-school education for 03-06 years old children, emergency medicines and contingencies.
- # Facilities are provided to 25 children in each crÃ"che.
- # Income eligibility of family whose monthly income is not more than Rs. 12,000/-
- # The Government assistance is limited to 90% of the schematic pattern or actual expenditure (except hono- rarium to crÃ"che workers) whichever is less and the remaining expenditure is borne by the Institution/ Organisation concerned. Government grant @ Rs 3532.00 per month per crÃ"che is given to the implementing agencies.
- # User charges of Rs.20/-from BPL families and Rs.60/- from other families per month.
