Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has introduced/purposes to introduce Pension Scheme for Anganwadi Workers and helpers;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the amount of pension fixed/proposed to be fixed in this regard;

(c) whether any States/UTs are providing pension to Ananwadi workers and helpers in the country; and

(d) if so, the details thereof along with the amount of pension being paid, State/UT-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI MANEKA SANJAY GANDHI)

(a): ICDS Scheme envisages the Aganwadi Workers (AWWs) and Anganwadi Helpers (AWHs) as " honorary workers" from the local community who come forward to render their services, on part-time basis, in the areas of child care and development. Being honorary worker AWWs/AWHs are paid fixed honorarium per month as decided by the Gove- rnment from time to time. Since AWWs/AWHs are honorary workers, the benefits like pension, gratuity and other allowances are not applicable to them. However, the States/ UTs can provide benefits beyond ICDS Scheme to the AWWs/AWHs from their own resources/ arrangements.
