(a-b-c) No, Madam. Earth system science organization India Meteorological Department (ESSO-IMD) does not issue seasonal and monthly forecasts for fog. this is the information for IGI Palam Airport based on climatiology prepared on the basis of data for the period 1980-2010, the number of days with fog in other cities of northern India during December to February is given in Annexure-I

(d-e) ESSO-IMD disseminates real time updates of possible fog development scenario in real time to Airport Authority of India (AAI) and Airport Operators/Airlines for taking appropriate action further.
