- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the proposals regarding budgetary allocation for conservation of Gogelav and Rotu (Jayal) village in Nagaur, Rajasthan is pending; and
- (d) if so, the quantum of budgetary allocation proposed to be made?

- (a) & (b) Yes, Sir. The Ministry has received proposals from the State Government of Rajasthan seeking financial assistance during the current financial year for twenty Protected Areas under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of 'Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats'.
- (c)&(d) No, Sir. The proposal regarding budgetary allocation for conservation of Gogelav and Rotu village had been received from Chief Wildlife Warden Rajasthan. The Ministry has released Rs. 10.40 lakh and Rs.8.00 lakh to Gogelav and Rotu Conservation Reserves respectively under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of 'Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats' in the current financial year.
