- (d) Total 4 schemes have been implemented by LNCPE, Thiruvananthapuram namely SAI Training centers 4 Nos., Special Area Games 2 Nos., Centre of Excellence 1 No. and 1 Physical Education Program. Total amount spent for the development of LNCPE Thiruvananthapuram is being collected and will be laid on the table of the house.
- (e) Yes, LNCPE, Thiruvananthapuram became the part of the academic wing of the SAI during the year 1986 and conducts the following courses:
- 1. Bachelor of Physical Education
- 2. Master of Physical Education
- 3. M. Phil.
- 4. Ph. D (Full time & Part-time)
- 5. Diploma in Sports Coaching.
- 6. Certificate Course in Sports Coaching.
