(a) to (f): During the 49th Annual Conference of Director Generals/Inspector Generals of Police held on 29th November, 2014, Hon'ble Prime Minister introduced the concept of S.M.A.R.T. Police wherein 'S' stands for Sensitive and Strict, 'M' for Modern with Mobility, Ã' for Alert and Accountable, 'R' for Reliable and Responsive and 'T' for Trained and Techno-savvy. The Government has decided to establish one model SMART Police Station in each State. BPR&D has prepared a plan for building of such Police Stations.
