- (a) whether there is a gap between wholesale price and retail price of sugarcane, if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether the Government proposes to take any steps including increase in Fair and Remunerative Price to bridge this gap and if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a): The Sugarcane (Control) Order, 1966 does not provide for any wholesale or retail price of sugarcane, rather, it provides for payment of Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) which is the benchmark price below which no sugar mill can purchase cane from sugarcane farmers.
- (b): No, Madam. The question does not arise.
