STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 21 FOR 25.02.2015 REGARDING "SLUM POPULATION".

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. As per the Census figures, the slum population in the country has increased from 5.23 crores in 2001 to 6.55 crores in 2011. Increased urbanization attracts migration from Rural areas and lack of affordable space in the cities for the urban population ordinarily results in increased slum population.
- (c) to (e): 'Land' and 'Colonisation' are State Subjects, accordingly State Governments and city Governments are responsible for policies and plan to address the issue of slums in an organised manner. In order to supplement the initiatives of State Governments, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation assists State Government to provide housing and basic civic and essential facilities for slum dwellers and urban poor through its schemes.
