- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The states of Tripura, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh have taken up power projects in private partnership to enhance their power generation capacity. One thermal project of 726.6 MW has been commissioned in Tripura. Four Hydro Projects (above 25 MW) aggregating to 2,120 MW in Sikkim and one Hydro project (above 25 MW) of 144 MW in Arunachal Pradesh have commenced construction.
