(a) & (b): Ratlam-Banswara-Dungarpur (176 Km) New Line has been taken up by Railways at an anticipated cost of `2083 crores. The Government of Rajasthan has agreed to provide land free of cost and to bear 50% of the construction cost. As a part of this share, the Government of Rajasthan has deposited `200 crore with Railways. Railways has been providing funds and utilisation of the fund depends on availability of land and requisite clearances. Details of funds provided for this project so far are as under:-

(c): Till date, land for 25 Km length has been handed over to Railways and earthwork & bridge work have been taken up in this stretch. Target date for completion of this project cannot be fixed in absence of availability of land for the entire project.
