(a) whether there is a shortage of life saving medical equipments/diagnostic machines and medi- cines in Government medical colleges/hospitals and affiliated hospitals including All India Institute of Medical Sciences;

(b) if so, the details thereof and reasons therefor, hospital-wise; and

(c) the corrective measures taken/ proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

## THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

(a) to (c): Since Health is a State Subject, no such information is maintained centrally. As far as AIIMS, New Delhi, JIPMER, Puducherry and three Central Gover- nment Hospitals in Delhi namely Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. RML Hospital and Lady Hardinge Medical College & associated Hospitals are concerned, there are no shor- tage of life saving equipment/diagnostic machines and medicines in these Hospitals/Institutes. In addition, procuring of equipment is continuous process and is taken up as per requirement and availability of funds.
