THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

- (a): Government of India under National Health Mission has taken several steps in all the States and UTs with regard to health issues related to women and children. Programmes/strategy being carried out by the Ministry in this regard is stated in the Annexure.
- (b) & (c): Norms are already relaxed for opening up Healthcare centres in desert, hilly and tribal areas of all States/UTs as may be seen from the tabulated statement below:

Centre Population Norms Plain Desert/Hilly/ Area Tribal Area

Sub-Centre 5000 3000 (SC)
Primary 30,000 20,000
Health
Centre (PHC)
Community 1,20,000 80,000
Health Centre (CHC)

In addition, a norm of "Time to care" has been adopted under which a Sub Centre can be set up within 30 minutes by walk from habitations in selected districts of hilly States and desert areas including Rajasthan.
