(a) & (b): Yes Madam, proposals have been received from Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Rajasthan to provide additional days of employment over and above the hundred days during the financial year 2014-15 in selected drought affected areas in the States. The details of the proposals is given below:

It was found that the percentage of households which availed 100 days' work during the current year has been very low/marginal in these States. Accordingly, the States have been advised to use the available provision of 100 days to all households in the drought affected areas first. Further, these cases have been referred to the High Powered Committee constituted in the Ministry of Home Affairs for decision in the matter.
