- (a) the details of sanitation coverage in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has reviewed the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) with regard to sanitation facilities in rural areas of the country including Jharkhand;
- (c) if so, the details and the outcome thereof; and
- (d) the funds spent on the SBM till date along with the funds estimated to be spent to achieve the target?

- (a) State/UT-wise % Rural households with access to toilet as per Census 2011 is at Annexure-1.
- (b) and (c) The Government has been constantly reviewing the Swachh Bharat Mission(Gramin) through its robust online monitoring systems, field visits, regional reviews and National Reviews. The States have been given sufficient flexibility for the implementation of the sanitation programme. The assistance for construction of IHHL has also been revised to Rs.12,000/-.
- (d) Under the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), in order to achieve the objectives by 2nd October 2019, the total central share requirement is Rs. 1,00,447 crore. Rs. 640.70 crore have been released by Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, from 2nd October, 2014 (launch of SBM(G)) to 28th February, 2015.,
