(a) to (d) This Ministry is primarily responsible for maintenance and development of National Highways (NHs). Besides, the Government provides funds to the State Governments /Union Territory Administrations for development of state roads (other than rural roads), under Central Road Fund (CRF) scheme and centrally sponsored schemes under Inter-State Connectivity and Economic Importance.

The development and maintenance of State Expressway/roads is the responsibility of the concerned State Governments. No State projects are taken over by this Ministry. As such questions do not arise.
