(a) whether the Government has approved a proposal of mandatory packaging of sugar and food grains in jute material to boost the jute sector;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether a proposal for financial support to Jute Corporation of India (JCI) was approved; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Ministry of Textiles has issued a Notification bearing No. S.O. 527(E) dated 13.02.2015 stipulating that minimum of 90% of foodgrain and minimum of 20% of sugar be compulsorily packed in jute packaging materials for the Jute year 2014-15, valid upto 30.06.2015.

(c) & (d): Yes, Madam. Government has approved annual grants of Rs.55.00 crores for 2014-15, Rs. 52.11 crores for 2015-16, Rs.49.38 crores for 2016-17 and Rs.46.78 crores for 2017-18 to Jute Corporation of India (JCI) for maintaining its infrastructure for Minimum Support Price (MSP) operation.
