## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) & (b): The gauge conversion of Sakri-Nirmali and Saharsa-Forbesganj (206 km) section has been taken up at an anticipated cost of `1250 crore and an expenditure of `256 crore has been incurred till March, 2014. As per the decision of Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, this project is funded by Ministry of Defence. The project has been progressing as per the funds released by Ministry of Defence.
- (c): The progress of the project is dependent on funding by Ministry of Defence. As such, no time frame has been fixed for completion of the project.
