(a) to (d): Survey for Pune-Nasik (265 km) new line has been completed and cost of the work has been assessed as `1899 crore (at 2009-10 price level) with Rate of Return of 4.11%. In view of its unremunerative nature and large throwforward of ongoing projects, the project has been shelved.
