- (d) the time by which these are likely to be completed?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.981 BY SHRI A. T. NANA PATIL TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 02.03.2015 REGARDING FACILITIES AT MAHARASHTRA STATIONS

(a) to (d): Works of Repairs to cover over platform, improvement to water stands posts, replacement of foot-over-bridge shed with GI sheet and provision of toilets were announced at Chalisgaon station and all works have been completed.

Works of improvement to waiting hall, PRS booking office, toilet, Entrance Gate, Circulating area and Boundary Wall, removal of OHE infringements for extension of Down Platform at Bhusawal end, repairs to cover over platform and replacement of existing steel tank by RCC tank of capacity 90,000 litre were announced at Pachora station and all works have been completed.

Works of improvement to circulating area & waiting hall, provision of upper class waiting room and construction of new station building have been planned at Amalner station and all works except construction of new station building have been completed.

Works of improvement to circulating area, provision of Foot Over Bridge, raising of platform No.2 from rail level to high level and construction of new station building at Dharangaon station have been planned and all works except new station building have been completed.

The target date for completion of new station buildings at Amalner and Dharangaon stations (as part of doubling project) is 30.06.2015.
