(a)&(d):There is no move to privatise Coal India Ltd. (CIL) by the Government. However to comply with SEBI guidelinesof minimum public shareholding of 25% for listed companies, the Government has disinvested 10% paid up equity capital in CIL out of Government of India's Shareholding of 89.65% through offer for sale (OFS) method on 30.01.2015. At present the Government of India's Shareholding in CIL is 79.65%
